

# Language and Math Requirements for Academic Majors

## Key

<b>Language</b>	These majors require two years (six courses) of college-level study in a second language or the equivalent through a placement test or prior academic credit.
<b>Math</b>	These majors require a minimum of one college-level math course and many of them require up to one year of college-level math or the equivalent.
<b>Either</b>	These majors allow you to choose between studying a second language, studying mathematics, or both.
<b>Optional</b>	These majors do not require studying a second language or studying math.
